



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR RYCO CABIN FILTER RCA316P.

JEEP Cherokee (KL)

- 1. The cabin air filter is located in the passenger footwell behind the centre console side trim. For better working space, slide the passenger seat all the way back.**
- 2. Remove the centre console lower side trim by pulling it gently. It is secured by clips that will release when pressure is applied.**
- 3. The cabin air filter housing will be behind the trim previously removed. Unclip the housing lid from the bottom section and pull the lid out. Slide out the old cabin air filter carefully to avoid any accumulated debris from being spread around.**
- 4. Clean the area well and insert the new cabin air filter in the right air flow direction and refit all components in reverse order.**

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
